

# Twisted Drop Stitch Scarf Pattern

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I often see people reaching my site by searching on twisted drop stitch scarf pattern or some combination thereof. Unfortunately for them they reach a finished project but no pattern. So for them (and the fact I may forget how to do this one day as my mind starts to break down with age) I have written out the pattern. This may be it for the patterns for a while.

## Materials:

[MC] Lion's Brand Thick and Quick; 3 skeins

1 set US 15 Needles

Gauge: 7st = 4"

## Notes:

Create a twisted drop stitch: Insert needle into the stitch as if to knit. Instead of wrapping the yarn around the back needle to create a regular knit stitch, wrap yarn around both needles and then wrap around the back needle. Complete stitch as you would normally.

## Pattern

- Cast on 21 stitches
- Row 1: k all stitches
- Row 2: k all stitches
- Row 3: Twisted Drop Stitch all stitches
- Row 4: k all stitches
- Row 5: k all stitches
- Row 6: k all stitches
- Row 7: Twisted Drop Stitch all stitches
- Repeat rows 1 – 7 until scarf equals desired length

## Finishing

Cut yarn leaving a 4-6" tail. Weave in ends.

## Tassels

Cut four 23" strands of yarn for each tassel. Fill up each scarf end with tassels. I used about 9 per side
