SIZES: To fit bust sizes Small: 32-34 (Medium: 36-38, Large: 40-46)"

KNITTING LEVEL: Intermediate

TECHNIQUES USED:

- Knitting in the round with circular needles
- Using stitch markers
- Knitting
- Purling
- Knitting 2 stitches together
- Knitting 2 stitches together through back loops
- Yarn Over
- Knit 1, slip 1, pass slipped stitch over



FINISHED MEASUREMENTS: Approximately 20 $\frac{1}{4}$ (22 $\frac{1}{4}$, 24 $\frac{1}{4}$)" long at front center to hem and 22 (23 $\frac{1}{2}$, 25)" around neck opening.

Instructions for size S start on page 2, for size M start on page 5, and for size L on page 8.

MATERIALS

- ♦ 6(7,8)-1.75oz/50g (62.3yds/57m) balls of GGH Aspen (50% Merino Wool/50% Acrylic) in Rose #14
- Size 11 (8mm) 32" circular knitting needles OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE
- 2 large stitch markers in different colors
- Yarn tapestry needle

GAUGE

❖ 14 stitches = 5" and 10 rows = 3" in Stockinette stitch PLEASE TAKE TIME TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE

TECHNIQUES REVIEW:

"Yarn Over" – To yarn over on a knit row, simply bring the yarn between your needle tips so it is in front (as if you were about to purl). When you knit the next stitch, you will have just created an extra loop on your right needle, which will be treated as a new stitch on your next row.

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"Slip 1, Knit 1, psso" – 1) To slip 1 stitch, just slip it from the left needle onto the right needle as if to knit it, i.e. insert your right needle into the stitch on your left needle from left to right into the front of the loop... just like you do when you knit a stitch, then just let it slip onto the right needle. 2) Then, knit 1 stitch as usual. 3) To "psso" (pass slipped stitch over), insert your left needle into the slipped stitch now sitting on your right needle and drag it over the stitch just knit and off the needle, just like you do when you bind off stitches at the end of a project. Remember to remove your left needle tip. You have just completed a "Slip 1, Knit 1, psso", which is essentially a way to decrease one stitch, but in a way that causes the decrease to slant to the right (for looks).

"Knit 2 together" - to decrease 1 stitch:



To knit 2 stitches together, insert your right needle tip into TWO stitches on your left needle from left to right, instead of just ONE.



Wrap yarn around your right needle tip as usual.



Bring this wrapped yarn through BOTH stitches to form your new knit stitch.

"Knit 2 together tbl" – "tbl" means "through back loops". Same to "knitting 2 together" above, except that you insert your right needle into the back halves of the 2 stitches on your left needle, then wrap your yarn around the right needle tip as usual, and bring the wrapped yarn through both stitches to form one new stitch. Using the back loops allows this decrease to slant to the left for a prettier effect in the lace pattern.

KNITTING THE PONCHO

Knitting Instructions for size S ONLY

Starting at the bottom hem of the poncho, cast on 170 stitches loosely. Spread the stitches evenly around the circular needle, being careful not to twist stitches, and join in the round.

Begin at hem with Garter Stitch and then the Scallop Lace Pattern as follows:

NOTE: Repeat instructions in brackets as many times as indicated right after brackets. Also, be sure to use a Row Counter OR use the checkboxes on the left of each Round to mark off each Round as you complete it.

\square Round 1: Place first marker ("marker #1") and note it's color here to mark the beginning of each round, purl 85, place a different color marker ("second marker"), purl 85.
\square Round 2: Slip marker #1, knit every stitch until you are back to marker #1, slipping second marker as you go.

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\square Round 3: Slip marker #1, purl every stitch until you are back to marker #1, slipping second marker as you go.
\square Round 4: Slip marker #1, knit every stitch until you are back to marker #1, slipping second marker as you go.
□ Round 5: (a lace pattern round) Slip marker #1, knit 6, *knit 1, knit 2 together 3 times, [yarn over, knit 1]5 times, yarn over, knit 2 together tbl 3 times; repeat from * 3 more times, knit 7, slip second marker, knit 6, **knit 1, knit 2 together 3 times, [yarn over, knit 1]5 times, yarn over, knit 2 together tbl 3 times; repeat from ** 3 more times, knit 7.
\square Round 6: (a decrease round) Slip marker #1, slip 1, knit 1, psso, knit until 2 stitches before the second marker, knit 2 together, slip second marker, slip 1, knit 1, psso, knit until 2 stitches before marker #1, knit 2 together = 166 stitches remain.
☐ Round 7: (work even – i.e. no shaping, just knit) Slip marker #1, knit every stitch until you are back to marker #1, slipping second marker as you go.
\square Round 8: Work a decrease round as in Round 6 = 162 stitches remain.
□ Round 9: Slip marker #1, knit 4, *knit 1, knit 2 together 3 times, [yarn over, knit 1]5 times, yarn over, knit 2 together tbl 3 times; repeat from * 3 more times, knit 5, slip second marker, knit 4, **knit 1, knit 2 together 3 times, [yarn over, knit 1]5 times, yarn over, knit 2 together tbl 3 times; repeat from ** 3 more times, knit 5.
Round 10: Work even as in Round 7.

Spread the stitches evenly around the circular needle, being careful not to twist stitches, and join in the round. Begin at hem with Garter Stitch and then the Scallop Lace Pattern as follows: NOTE: Repeat instructions in brackets as many times as indicated right after brackets. Also, be sure to use a Row Counter OR use the checkboxes on the left of each Round to mark off each Round as you complete it.

Knitting Instructions for size L ONLY

Starting at the bottom hem of the poncho, cast on 210 stitches loosely. Spread the stitches evenly around the circular needle, being careful not to twist stitches, and join in the round.

Begin at hem with Garter Stitch and then the Scallop Lace Pattern as follows:

NOTE: Repeat instructions in brackets as many times as indicated right after brackets. Also, be sure to use a Row Counter OR use the checkboxes on the left of each Round to mark off each Round as you complete it.

\square Round 1: Place first marker ("marker #1") and note it's color here to mark the beginning of each round, purl 105, place a different color marker ("second marker"), purl 105.
\square Round 2: Slip marker #1, knit every stitch until you are back to marker #1, slipping second marker as you go.
\square Round 3: Slip marker #1, purl every stitch until you are back to marker #1, slipping second marker as you go.
\square Round 4: Slip marker #1, knit every stitch until you are back to marker #1, slipping second marker as you go.
□ Round 5: (a lace pattern round) Slip marker #1, knit 7, *knit 1, knit 2 together 3 times, [yarn over, knit 1]5 times, yarn over, knit 2 together tbl 3 times; repeat from * 4 more times, knit 8, slip second marker, knit 7, **knit 1, knit 2 together 3 times, [yarn over, knit 1]5 times, yarn over, knit 2 together tbl 3 times; repeat from ** 4 more times, knit 8.

FINISHING FOR ALL SIZES

Weave in all loose ends. Lay flat on an ironing surface and pin the scalloped edges down flat. Steam with a warm iron to flatten out natural curling tendency of the hem. Repeat around entire border.

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CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Hand wash in cool water. Roll gently in towel to remove excess water (do not twist or wring), and lay flat to dry.
